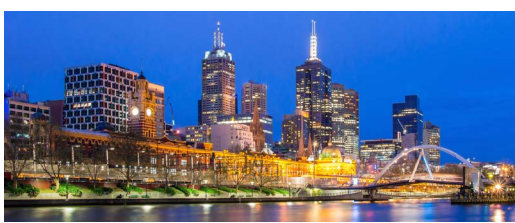

CROSS INTERNATIONAL DATELINE AND LOSE A DAY**

**NOV 7
ARRIVE SYDNEY**

G'Day and welcome to Sydney where you will be met and assisted with your transfer to the Hotel. Note – check in time is 2PM. You can store your bag and explore until rooms are ready.

**NOV 8
SYDNEY CITY TOUR AND EVENING WELCOME DINNER
HARBOUR CRUISE (BD)**

Drive through the historic 'Rocks' area where Australia was first founded with its maze of terrace houses, restored warehouses, pubs and restaurants. Drive under the famous 'coat hanger', the Sydney Harbour Bridge and view Sydney's famous architectural masterpiece, the Sydney Opera House.

Continue through the commercial area of the city passing the historical buildings of Macquarie Street – Parliament House, The Mint and Hyde Park Barracks. Alight at Mrs Macquarie's Chair for breathtaking views of the city and harbour. Return to the city via famous Bondi Beach and Paddington, a Victorian suburb of restored terrace houses richly decorated with cast-iron lace. The tour will end back at the hotel.

Enjoy some free time to explore on your own or relax by the harbourside until dinner. This evening meet your local guide at the hotel who will walk you down to the pier for your Captain Cook sunset dinner cruise. Included is a 3 course menu with House beer, wine and soft drinks. At the end of the cruise walk back to the hotel.

**NOV 9
SYDNEY OPERA HOUSE (B)**

Enjoy the morning at leisure.

This afternoon take a leisurely walk from the hotel to the Opera House for a private guided walking tour.

Visitors are guided into theatres, given a fascinating account of the history and architecture of the House and introduced to the magic of performance. With its white, sculptural 'shells' rising from the harbour foreshore at Bennelong Point, the Opera House is Sydney's most recognisable building and, officially, one of the seven wonders of the 20th century. Joern Utzon, the Danish architect who designed the Opera House, ascribed the inspiration

for his masterpiece to the sails of yachts on the harbour. At the end of the tour enjoy the rest of the day free to explore on your own.

**NOV 10
SYDNEY FREE DAY (B)
OPTIONAL BLUE MOUNTAINS DAY TOUR**

Your informative and knowledgeable guide will collect you from your Sydney hotel as we commence our small group deluxe tour into the heart of the unique Blue Mountains World Heritage Region. The Blue Mountains National Park is one of seven national parks that make up the Greater Blue Mountains World Heritage Area. This wonderland of sandstone outcrops, deep ravines and hazy blue eucalypt forests boasts luxury retreats and the world's steepest railway.

Visit To Scenic World Including Railway, Skyway, Cableway And Walkway.

We will quietly glide down into the valley floor aboard the steepest aerial cable car in Australia! Our journey takes us on a 545 metre ride into the World Heritage Listed rainforest of the Jamison Valley, stroll along the walkway through towering Jurassic rainforest, and refresh both your spirit and soul! We ascend back to the Ridgetop via the Steepest Incline Railway in the world!

Lunch Stop At Blue Mountains.

Continue the drive along Cliff Drive to Echo Point to view the famous "Three Sisters".

On your return travel through Olympic Park before returning to the hotel.

KURANDA TOUR INCLUDING SKYRAIL & TJAPUKAI ABORIGINAL CULTURAL PARK (B)**

You will be met by your local guide and transferred by private coach to Freshwater Station. Here you will board the historic Kuranda Rail for one of the most spectacular rail journeys in Australia. Travelling slowly, it winds its way up the epic pioneer track with every turn revealing a new panorama - sugar plantations, Barron Falls, Stoney Creek Falls for 90 minutes until it reaches Kuranda Station, a cool, tropical environment of native shrubs, ferns and flowers.

On arrival in Kuranda enjoy free time to stroll around in the World Heritage Rainforest village, visit the famous Kuranda Markets and enjoy amazing "street art" around every corner. After our visit to Kuranda Village we board the Skyrail Rainforest Cableway for an amazing experience over Australia's World Heritage listed Tropical Rainforest canopy and deep in the forest. Gliding just metres above the rainforest canopy in comfortable six-person gondola cabins, the Skyrail immerses you in an intimate rainforest experience where you will see, hear, smell and become part of the tropical rainforest environment. At the end of the Skyrail we take a short walk to Tjapukai Aboriginal Cultural Park.

Tjapukai by Day is a celebration of the living history of the Indigenous people of the rainforest. Learn to play the didgeridoo, discover the medicinal values of bush tucker, throw a spear and enjoy professional theatre incorporating traditional Aboriginal dance, fire making and storytelling. New to Tjapukai is a genuine cultural and visual Australian journey featuring the didgeridoo plus an expansion of the Cultural Village's program to include hunting demonstrations. At the end of the visit reboard your coach for the transfer back to the hotel.
